July 13th saw the launch of this summer's Twilight Market season. This year, we have welcomed new vendors and community groups, growing the total stalls to 18! The market footprint has been brought up to North Main Street between Church and Fremont Streets to highlight more of our businesses downtown. August's Twilight Market will also coincide with BID's Kid's Chalk Art on Main. Micropolis turns seven!

Seven years ago in March, a group of citizens held a meeting to discuss the feasibility of forming a cooperative for area artists. They met inside the soon-to-be new location of Mohawk Harvest while floors were still being sanded and heat was not yet fully functioning. Twenty individuals with questions and ideas arrived carrying their own chairs.

Four months later, on July 27, 2011 the newly formed Micropolis Cooperative, Inc. partnered with the Sacandaga Valley Arts Net-



work (SVAN) to present the first "Art on Main" in downtown Gloversville. It was a celebration of artwork by regional artists held in two locations simultaneously— at the Fulton County Chamber Rotun-

da Gallery and at Micropolis. Since that first event, the art co-op has held a "Meet the Artists" reception every two months, unveiling a new show and introducing a featured artist.

Because of its location inside Mohawk Harvest, the gallery is fortunate to be open seven days a week enabling Micropolis to carry out its mission to:

- provide artists with an opportunity to exhibit and sell their artwork
- build awareness of and support for the regional art community
- be a part of the revitalization of downtown
